INT. DARKROOM

It THUNDERS. A FLAME is lit in the darkness by a PAGAN, whose face is hidden, swallowed by shadows with the shape of prison-like bars from an unseen window.

EXT. CATHEDRAL - NIGHT (MONTHS BEFORE)

Title over: 1722, IRELAND.

Lightning arcs the clouds above the imposing Dublin's Cathedral, the highest building of the whole town.

INT. CATHEDRAL - MAIN HALL - CONTINUES

Priests GREGORY (60) and NOLAN ('20s) hold torches and stare at a DEAD BODY on the floor. A teenager with his face burned.

EXT. CATHEDRAL BACK DOOR - CONTINUES

The heavy back doors open.

The two priests drag the body out of the building, now wrapped in white robes. Gregory looks around, apprehensively, to make sure no one is seeing this, and then looks at Nolan.

THEY BURN THE BODY.

They pray with their rosaries in front of the flames but Nolan is sick, he covers his nose and pukes with the smell.
