On the shelf, there's Sarah's high school yearbook with the word BITCH and SLUT near her picture.

No signatures, no dedications.

A picture of Sarah graduating. She has a sad smile with a group of happy students away from her in the background.

SARAH (V.O.) CONT'D
These likes, these apps, fake
smiles, and empty content. A
Worthless degree, no career. Too
big dreams for a too-small world.
It doesn't matter how smart you
are, how hard you work for a
limited period of meaningless

(checks social account)

A LIGHTNING flashes from the window and then a THUNDER.

INSERT PC - Sarah (V.O.) types:
 "I am tired of everything that exists"

MATCH CUT TO:

INT. HOUSE - RAINY MORNING (Present time)

Someone KNOCKS at the door. Dot-dot-dot.

The house is a complete mess. The coffee machine spreads coffee all over the place.

SLING (O.S.)

It's the detective Moore, we spoke over the phone.

(knocks again)

Mr. Todd are you there?

Mr. Todd opens the door to the detectives' SLING WILMOTT (27) and BROOKE KING (30's) who show him their identification card.

They're wearing face masks and gloves.

The detectives look around as they enter the living room.

INT. LIVING ROOM - CONTINUES

They're on the couch. MR. Todd serves a dirty cup of coffee to Brooke and a beer for him and Sling while they speak, but Sling refuses it.

SLING

No thank you. Did you try to contact her? When was the last time you spoke?

MR. TODD

Her phone is off, since Tuesday.

BROOKE

We understand this must be difficult for you sir but you need to cooperate.

SLING

We just need to ask you a few questions.

Brooke puts a sound recorder on the table.

BROOKE

Is Sarah your biological daughter? From your first and only marriage with Johane Todd?

MR. TODD

Yes.

BROOKE

Date of birth. Medical papers.

MR. TODD

13 of September 1995.

Mr. Todd gives them Sarah's medical papers.

SLING

So she's not a minor. Were you and your family diagnosed with the virus recently?

MR. TODD

Sarah was. She returned from Europe recently.

SLING
